## Varieties in Cultural Thinking

- We didn't know there was anything to think about.
- Majority culture doesn't know it needs to think culturally.
- Majority culture doesn't always realize that culture affects our theological thinking.
- Some do know, and it is racist, on purpose.

### Assumptions of the Elite

- Manifest Destiny or entitlement
- Being an urban gentrifier means I am about social involvement.
- Mercy tourism, or drive by mercy suffices for social justice.
- Reconciliation is a joint service, a black speaker, a movie, an idea but not a lifestyle pursuit.

### The way it is, or the way it looks?

- Is the PCA "a bastion of white privilege?"
- You are not my demographic target, so I have the option not to pursue you.
  [Benign neglect]
- If it is not racist in intent but racial in effect, is it racist?

 Is being blind to the people we have not included say anything about the spiritual quality of our lives, or our theology?

# Pessimism as an underlying assumption.

- Problems are intractable.
- Other side won't change, no matter what we do nothing will change.
- Justice will never be satisfied.
- Powerful use structure and the law to preserve their power.

### Blame & Shame game

- Europeans think "legally" to prevent and deal with conflict.
- There is always someone to blame, and if you are to blame you are responsible, and you should pay.
- Resist acceptance of blame, avoid conversations and feelings leading to such.
- Resistant to corporate responsibility
- Legality trumps humanity.



### Group thinking

- Solidarity with the community versus individualism.
- You represent a community whether you like it or not.
- Legalistic individualism doesn't relieve you of taking a stand, or taking a step.

### **Theological Contortions**

- Evangelism can be refused if you are not the right target.
- Evangelism can be pursued without regard to your physical need.
- Evangelism can be pursued without bringing you into the Body.
- Evangelism can be successful without serving your culture.

### Tools of the Trade

- We start with love [2 Cor 5]
- We start with a new look at people
- We have this mandate from God
- We have this act of Jesus [Eph 2]
- We have a radical identity which produces a radical ability [I Cor 9]
- We can raise a harvest [James 3:18]

### The Power of Love

- Love is the assertive force in reconciliation.
- Love is demonstrated by a deeply honest humility in regard to justice and reconciliation.
- Reciprocal love is demonstrated by forgiveness.
- Love cannot deny the human condition.
